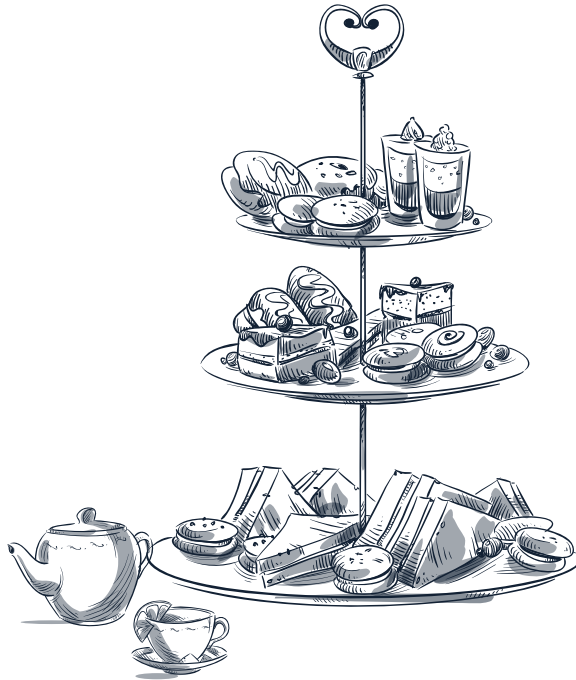
A MOMENT *In History*

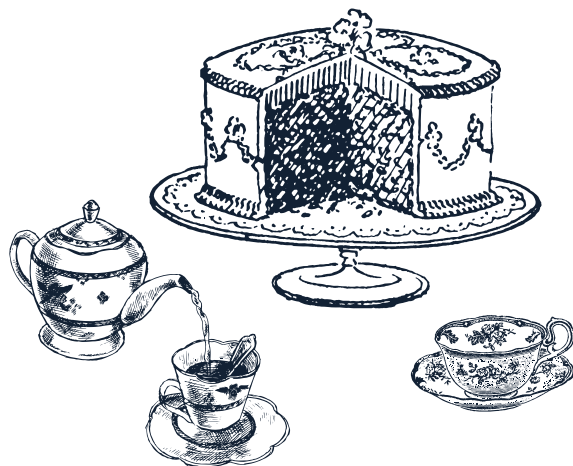

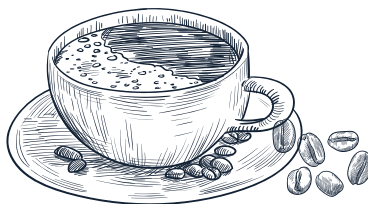

THE HISTORY OF *Afternoon Tea*

Afternoon Tea emerged in the 19th century and is still known across the world as one of the quintessential English customs. While drinking tea in England became popular in 1660 afternoon teas didn't appear until the mid-19th century.

In 1840, Anna, the seventh Duchess of Bedford introduced afternoon tea to fill the gap between lunch and the late 8pm dinner. She initiated the tradition of serving up trays of bread, butter and cake during the afternoon inviting friends to partake. This practice gained popularity among the upper class by the 1880's, evolving into a fashionable social event.
